NORTH IDAHO DEFERRED MAINTENANCE

Verdis was the prime contractor for the design-build contract, including upgrades and maintenance for North Idaho College, Department of Parks & Recreation, Department of Labor, Idaho State Police, Department of Lands, and Idaho Military Division. Tasks included replacement/upgrades to utilities, HVAC, electrical, roofing, site improvements, windows, doors, elevators, backup generators, restrooms, and sidewalks. The work included buildings critical to the operations of each agency and provided necessary upgrades in efficiency, building use, and occupancy.

USFS DISPATCH OFFICE

Verdis was the prime contractor for renovation of the USFS Interagency Dispatch Center. The office space is used by multiple agencies and remained operational during the renovation. The renovation included an updated floorplan for the office space to provide additional functionality and capacity for the operational needs of all agencies. The renovation included new HVAC, electrical, plumbing, fire suppression, and data to accommodate the new walls, office space, and conference areas. All finishes were completed including walls, flooring, ceilings, and casework.

CAVANAUGH HOUSE UPDATE

Verdis was prime contractor on this historic building renovation. Work included selective demolition of the breakfast nook, bathrooms, kitchen, master bedroom and adjoining hallway. Kitchen renovations included wall reconfigurations, new cabinets/countertops, electrical, paint, tile floor and appliances. Verdis also installed new doors and hardware, historic hardwood floors and stair refinish and repair, window treatments, lighting, asbestos abatement and lead abatement.

LOWER GRANITE DAM MAINTENANCE BENCH & SLOPE STABILIZATION

Verdis was the prime contractor for soil and rock excavation on an extremely steep slope located underneath an active fish ladder. Concrete retaining walls up to 16 feet tall were installed on the downhill side, and 180 1-inch diameter rock anchors were drilled 6 feet into the rock face with wire mesh to support shotcrete slope stabilization on the uphill side. These foundation operations allowed construction of a concrete access ramp and storage area, entailing 5,000 square feet of concrete paving. Additional infrastructure included a storm water management system to pass water from the slope to the adjacent river.

CHATCOLET MARINA REPLACEMENT

Verdis was the prime contractor for the design/build effort to replace and expand the Chatcolet Marina and parking lot at Heyburn State Park. The project scope includes a state of the art 164-slip marina with fueling and sanitary services, a 1,064-foot-long, 8-foot-wide community-accessible breakwater, new boat launch, parking lot, general store and public promenade.
